Drs. Reid Ikeda, Andrew Pham, Gehan Devendra and colleagues were published in *Scientific Reports* for their article "Serial biomarker measurements may be helpful to predict the successful application of high flow nasal cannula in COVID-19 pneumonia patients". The study investigates how monitoring C-reactive protein (CRP) and D-dimer levels can help predict the effectiveness of high flow nasal cannula (HFNC) therapy in COVID-19 pneumonia patients facing acute respiratory failure.
