II. <u>Objectives</u>

The structured hematology oncology elective is designed to provide training for those students who may wish to pursue careers in community based practice. General internal medicine aspects of cancer diagnosis, prevention, and patient care will be emphasized thus making this attachment especially relevant for primary care and general internal medicine training in addition to providing an introduction to medical hematology oncology sub specialization.

III. <u>Method</u>

<u>Core Clinical</u>: A core clinical attachment is offered where the emphasis is placed on outpatient care whenever possible. Students will make the initial contact with patients and then present their impressions and recommendations to the attending physician.
