II. Objectives

To provide a supportive learning environment for the medical student to increase their knowledge in the management of acute and chronic pulmonary disease.

III. Method

- Work with adult patients in the hospital and the clinic
 - Should follow at least 2 consults a day and write a note on that patient Preference is to start with a new consult.
- Present patients during daily rounds.
- Attendance at the Internal Medicine SAS on Tuesday afternoon
- Present one article per week pertaining to a patient they saw that week
- Observe and participate in pulmonary procedures

IV. Evaluation

1. Observational evaluation by the supervising physicians will assess the student's medical knowledge, clinical skills, and professionalism.
